Anchor Pieces to Decide First

■ Choose your anchor piece first (usually the sofa or rug), then build every other decision around it. Starting with small accessories leads to mismatched rooms that are expensive to fix.

Layout Concept A

Sketch your first arrangement. Use the dot grid below — one dot square \approx 1 foot. Draw rectangles to represent your furniture.



Layout A Notes

Traffic flow notes	Best view / focal point	What works?	What needs work?

- Take a photo of the current room from the doorway before you rearrange. Then take one after. Seeing them side by side reveals more than any tape measure.

Layout Concept B

Try a second arrangement before making purchases. A small shift often changes the whole room — especially pulling furniture off the walls.

- Most people push furniture against the walls. Pulling pieces 6–12 inches inward creates a more intimate, intentional arrangement — and usually makes the room feel larger, not smaller.

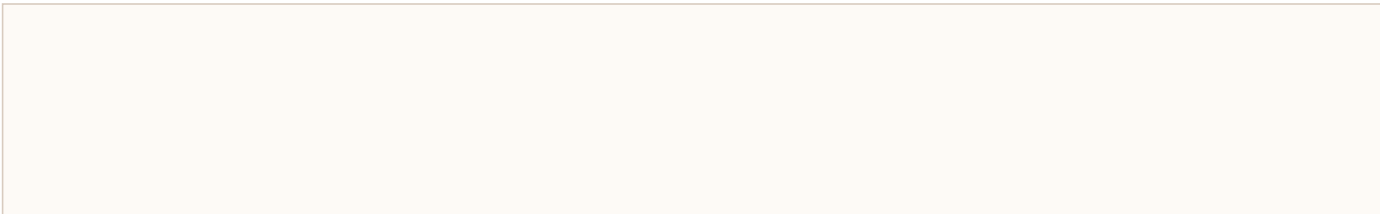
